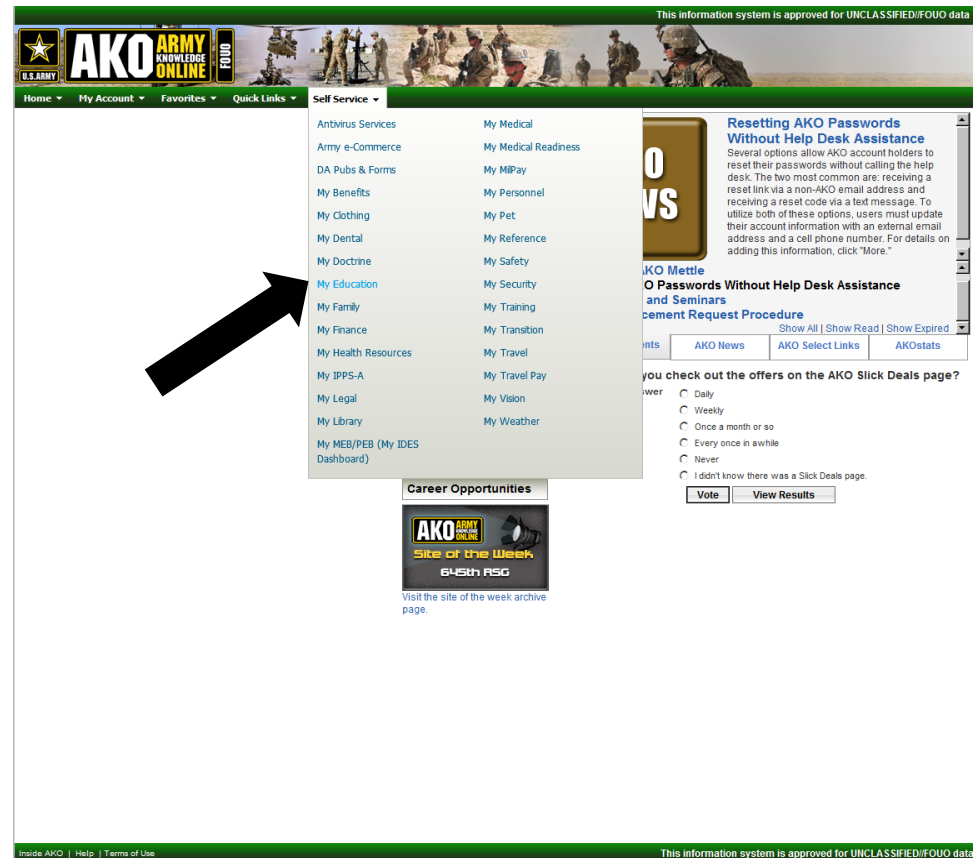

Notice (2 DEC 2014)

1. OPSEC Training V2 on the ALMS was discontinued 22 AUG 2013 by the proponent.
2. For current Army-wide standardized computer web-based security training requirements, refer to ALARACT 207/2013. (Does not replace OPSEC training requirements).
3. The courses "Initial Security Orientation" and "Annual Security Refresher" are now available in the ALMS. These courses are Army-wide requirements for all military, civilian, and contractors referenced in ALARACT 207/2013.

General Notice - The ALMS will be offline on the fourth Wednesday of each month for routine maintenance, typically from 7PM Eastern time Wednesday until 2AM Thursday.

The ALMS, an integral component of the Army Distributed Learning System (DLS), and is the Army's automated system for individual training management. The ALMS delivers training developed by TRADOC and other proponents to Soldiers and DA Civilians, manages training information, provides training collaboration, scheduling, and career planning capabilities in both resident and non-resident training environments.

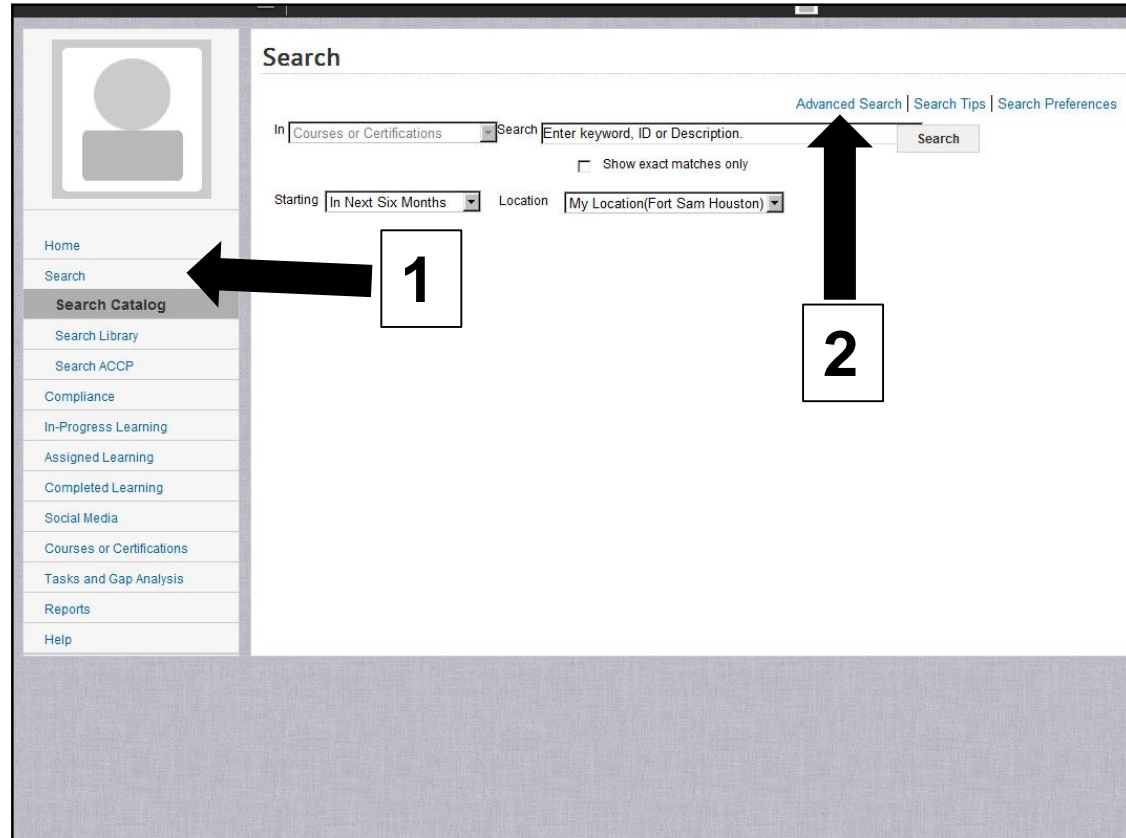
