1. (U) SITUATION.

1.A. (U) CURRENT OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATIONS EXCEED THE
DISTRIBUTABLE INVENTORY IN THE ACTIVE ARMY. THIS PRECLUDES U.S. ARMY HUMAN RESOURCES
COMMAND (HRC) FROM MANNING ALL UNITS TO 100% FILL WITH THE CORRECT SKILL AND GRADE. TO
SUSTAIN ARMY READINESS AT THE HIGHEST LEVELS, ACTIVE COMPONENT MANNING GUIDANCE
(ACMG) PRIORITIZES HOW THE ARMY FILLS ITS UNITS. THIS PRIORITIZATION IS BASED ON GUIDANCE
RECEIVED FROM THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF THE ARMY (CSA) AND THE DYNAMIC ARMY RESOURCING

PRIORITY LIST (DARPL) PUBLISHED BY THE HEADQUARTERS, DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (HQDA) DEPUTY CHIEF OF STAFF (DCS), G-3/5/7.

1.B. (U) CSA GUIDANCE REQUIRES HQDA TO PUBLISH HQDA EXORD 070-19 IN SUPPORT OF (ISO) FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 (FY19-20) ACMG. THIS UPDATE TO ACMG IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY DIRECTION TO SUSTAIN OPTIMAL UNIT READINESS TO MEET CURRENT DEMAND AND EMERGING REQUIREMENTS WHILE MAINTAINING NECESSARY THROUGH-PUT CAPACITY IN THE GENERATING FORCE.

1.C. (U) COMMANDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MANAGING NON-DEPLOYABLE SOLDIERS, ASSIGNED MILITARY OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTIES (MOS) SKILLS MATCH, AND GRADE DISTRIBUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH (IAW) ARMY REGULATION (AR) 220-1. SENIOR COMMANDERS HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ADJUST PERSONNEL FILL LEVELS ACROSS THEIR INSTALLATION TO MEET MISSION REQUIREMENTS.

2. (U) MISSION. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, THE U.S. ARMY DISTRIBUTES PERSONNEL ACROSS THE ACTIVE COMPONENT BASED ON ARMY PRIORITIES IN ORDER TO BUILD AND PRESERVE THE HIGHEST LEVEL POSSIBLE OF UNIT AND SERVICE-LEVEL READINESS.

3. (U) EXECUTION.

3.A. (U) INTENT. MAN THE ARMY IAW CSA'S PRIORITIES AS ARTICULATED BY THE HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7, AND IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE APPROVED END STRENGTH PUBLISHED ANNUALLY IN THE NATIONAL DEFENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT (NDAA).

3.A.1. (U) PURPOSE. THE PURPOSE OF THE FY19-20 ACMG IS TO OPTIMIZE PERSONNEL READINESS BY ALIGNING ACMG TO SPECIFIED CSA PRIORITIES AND THE DARPL.

3.A.2. (U) KEY TASKS.

3.A.2.A. (U) DISTRIBUTE PERSONNEL IAW ARMY PRIORITIES (CSA GUIDANCE/DARPL).

3.A.2.B. (U) MANAGE NON-DEPLOYABLE SOLDIERS TO MAXIMIZE UNIT READINESS WHILE TREATING ALL PERSONNEL WITH DIGNITY AND RESPECT.

3.A.3.C. (U) SELECT, TRAIN, EDUCATE, AND PROMOTE (STEP) ELIGIBLE SPECIALISTS (SPC) AND SERGEANTS (SGT) TO GROW THE NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICER (NCO) CORPS REQUIRED TO EXECUTE ARMY MISSIONS ACROSS THE ENTERPRISE AND IMPROVE STAR MOS SKILLS MATCH WHILE ENHANCING READINESS.

3.A.3.D. (U) BUILD AND PRESERVE THE HIGHEST LEVEL POSSIBLE OF UNIT AND SERVICE-LEVEL READINESS WHILE MINIMIZING RISK TO MEET OPERATIONAL DEMANDS.

3.A.4. (U) END STATE. THE U.S. ARMY'S MANNING ENTERPRISE SETS CONDITIONS FOR ACTIVE ARMY PERSONNEL READINESS ACCORDING TO THE CSA'S PRIORITIES AND THE DARPL.

3.B. (U) CONCEPT OF THE OPERATION. THE BEST WAY TO ARTICULATE ARMY PRIORITIES AS ESTABLISHED IN THE DARPL IS TO CREATE FOUR ACMG MANNING

CATEGORIES. CATEGORY 1 CONSISTS OF SPECIFIC POSITIONS AND UNITS FOCUSED ON THE CSA'S HIGHEST PRIORITIES. CATEGORY 2 IS COMPOSED OF UNITS ASSIGNED TO HIGH PRIORITY NATIONAL/ARMY MISSIONS. CATEGORY 3 ENTAILS UNITS THAT SUPPORT INSTITUTIONAL ARMY REQUIREMENTS AND SELECT ARMY HEADQUARTERS (HQ) UNITS. CATEGORY 4 IS COMPOSED OF HQS WHERE PRIORITY OF FILL IS NECESSARILY LOWER TO ACHIEVE MANNING GUIDANCE IN CATEGORIES 1-3.

3.B.1. (U) ACMG MANNING CATEGORIES. ACTIVE COMPONENT POSITIONS OR UNITS FALL INTO ONE (1) OF FOUR (4) MANNING CATEGORIES AS OUTLINED ABOVE AND DESCRIBED IN GREATER DETAIL IN ANNEX A. THE DARPL PRIORITIZES ARMY UNITS IN A 1-N SEQUENCE BASED ON CSA PRIORITIES. THE ACMG FURTHER PRIORITIZES UNITS WITHIN EACH MANNING CATEGORY. THIS UNIT PRIORITIZATION GUIDES THE DISTRIBUTION OF PERSONNEL WITH PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO SOLDIERS IN LOW-DENSITY CAREER FIELDS. AS A RESULT, LOWER PRIORITY UNITS CAN EXPECT TO RECEIVE FEWER ARMY-WIDE SHORTAGE AREAS OF CONCENTRATION (AOC)/MOS SOLDIERS.

3.B.1.A. (U) CATEGORY 1 UNITS AND POSITIONS, IDENTIFIED IN ANNEX B, CONSIST OF UNITS AND POSITIONS WITHIN THE OPERATING AND GENERATING FORCE THAT SUPPORT THE CSA'S TOP PRIORITIES AND DARPL CATEGORY A OPERATIONS, MISSIONS, AND EXERCISES. THE TARGET MANNING LEVEL FOR CATEGORY 1 UNITS IS 100% IN THE AGGREGATE WITH BRIGADE AND BELOW LEVEL UNITS FILLED FIRST.

3.B.1.B. (U) CATEGORY 2 UNITS, IDENTIFIED IN ANNEX B, ARE ORGANIZATIONS WITHIN THE OPERATING FORCE THAT SUPPORT DARPL CATEGORIES A AND B OPERATIONS, MISSIONS, AND EXERCISES. THE MINIMUM AGGREGATE MANNING LEVEL FOR CATEGORY 2 UNITS IS 90%. THE PLANNED MANNING LEVEL IS 95%. REQUIREMENTS CONFIRMED SEMI-ANNUALLY AT THE ARMY SYNCHRONIZATION RESOURCE CONFERENCE.

3.B.1.C. (U) CATEGORY 3 UNITS, IDENTIFIED IN ANNEX B, ARE ORGANIZATIONS WITHIN THE GENERATING FORCE/INSTITUTIONAL ARMY THAT SUPPORT DARPL CATEGORIES B AND C OPERATIONS, MISSIONS, AND EXERCISES. SELECT ARMY HQ ABOVE THE BRIGADE LEVEL ARE ALSO IN CATEGORY 3. THE MINIMUM MANNING LEVEL FOR CATEGORY 3 UNITS IS 70%, PLANNED AT 85% IN THE AGGREGATE.

3.B.1.D. (U) CATEGORY 4 UNITS, IDENTIFIED IN ANNEX B, CONSIST OF ARMY HQ UNITS ABOVE THE BRIGADE LEVEL. THE MINIMUM MANNING LEVEL FOR CATEGORY 4 UNITS IS MINIMUM 65%, PLANNED AT 80% IN THE AGGREGATE.

3.B.2. (U) SHORTAGE MOSS AND AOCS. SOME ENLISTED AND WARRANT MOSS, ALONG WITH OFFICER AOCS ARE ROUTINELY UNDER STRENGTH. THE LISTING OF THE CURRENT "SHORTAGE" MOSS AND AOCS, WITH 90-DAY PROJECTED FILL RATES, ARE PROVIDED IN ANNEX C. THIS SHORTAGE LISTING IS UPDATED QUARTERLY BY HRC AND PUBLISHED ON THE FOLLOWING LINK:

3.B.3. (U) SPECIAL MISSION UNITS. SPECIAL MISSION UNITS ARE LISTED IN CLASSIFIED ANNEX D ALONG WITH CORRESPONDING TARGET MANNING LEVELS.

3.B.4. (U) DARPL 1-N PRIORITIZED LIST OF UNITS. THE MANNING-FOCUSED 1-N PRIORITIZED LIST OF UNITS ARE LISTED IN ANNEX E.

3.B.5. (U) MANNING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ). FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING ACTIVE COMPONENT MANNING GUIDANCE ARE ADDRESSED IN ANNEX F.

3.C. (U) TASKS TO ARMY STAFF, AND SUBORDINATE UNITS.

3.C.1. (U) HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7.

3.C.1.A. (U) UPDATE AND PUBLISH DARPL WHEN A UNIT'S PRIORITY IS INCORRECTLY MAPPED TO A REQUIREMENT. HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 (DAMO-SSG) RECEIVES DARPL (MANNING) ADJUSTMENT REQUESTS FROM ARMY COMMANDS (ACOM) AND ARMY SERVICES COMPONENT COMMANDS (ASCC). IN CONJUNCTION WITH DARPL UPDATES, BE PREPARED TO STAFF THESE REQUESTS FOR DECISION AT THE ARMY SYNCHRONIZATION RESOURCING CONFERENCE (ASRC). SINCE THE DARPL PRIMARILY ALIGNS UNIT IDENTIFICATION CODES (UIC) WITH INTEGRATED REQUIREMENTS PRIORITY LIST (IRPL) REQUIREMENTS, HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 (DAMO-FM) PUBLISHES THE DARPL TWO (2) TIMES PER YEAR IN CONJUNCTION WITH RESULTS OF THE ASRC. OUT OF CYCLE DARPL PUBLICATIONS WILL BE BASED ON HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 GUIDANCE. HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 (DAMO-FM) WILL PROVIDE THE ENTIRE DARPL TO UNITS ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS. WILL MAINTAIN, PUBLISH, AND SERVE AS THE PROPONENT OF AR 525-29 (REFERENCE H).

3.C.1.B. (U) IN COORDINATION WITH HQDA DCS, G-1, PUBLISH ACMG EXORD AND ALL FRAGOS, AS NECESSARY.

3.C.1.C. (U) IN COORDINATION WITH U.S. ARMY FORCES COMMAND (FORSCOM) AND ASCCS, PROVIDE VISIBILITY TO HQDA DCS, G-1 AND HRC OF:

3.C.1.C.1. (U) ALL UNITS PROJECTED TO DEPLOY, BY UIC, AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, AND NOT LATER THAN (NLT) 270 DAYS PRIOR TO MISSION ASSUMPTION DATE.

3.C.1.C.2. (U) ALL CULMINATING TRAINING EVENT (CTE) SCHEDULES FOR BRIGADE COMBAT TEAMS (BCT), COMBAT AVIATION BRIGADES (CAB), MULTI-FUNCTIONAL SUPPORT BRIGADES (MFSB), FUNCTIONAL SUPPORT BRIGADES (FSB), CORPS AND DIVISION HQS, AND SUSTAINMENT HQS, AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE, BUT NLT 180 DAYS PRIOR TO CTE.

3.C.1.C.3. (U) EMERGING AND UNFORECASTED REQUIREMENTS, TO INCLUDE CHANGES TO PRIORITIES OF FILL AND IDENTIFIED DONOR UNITS, IN-ACTIVATIONS, ACTIVATIONS, UNIT MOVES, AND CONVERSIONS, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, BUT NLT 365 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REQUIREMENT.

3.C.1.D. (U) ADJUDICATE DIRECTED MILITARY OVER-STRENGTH (DMO) REQUESTS FROM ACOM AND ASCC. CONSIDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES SUCH AS DMO ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS, WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT EVERY DMO DETRACTS FROM HRC'S ABILITY TO APPLY PRECISION MANNING TO PRIORITIZED UNITS. DMO REQUESTS ARE ASSESSED BY HQDA DCS, G-3/5/7 (DAMO-FM) AGAINST THE CRITERIA OUTLINED IN AR 570-4, PARAGRAPH 6-11 (REFERENCE I), AND WILL INCLUDE PURPOSE, BACKGROUND, DISCUSSION, AND RATIONALE SECTIONS.

3.C.2. (U) HQDA, DCS, G-1.

3.C.2.A. (U) MAINTAIN, PUBLISH, AND SERVE AS THE PROPONENT OF THE ACMG.

3.C.3.B. (U) PROVIDE ANALYSIS OF IDENTIFIED SKILL AND GRADE SHORTFALLS TO HQDA DCS, G-1.

3.C.4. (U) COMMANDERS, ARMY COMMANDS (ACOM) AND ARMY SERVICE COMPONENT COMMANDS (ASCC).

3.C.4.A. (U) REPORT NON-DEPLOYABLE SOLDIERS IAW AR 220-1 (REFERENCE F).

Manning FAQs:

What measures can my unit take to improve its personnel readiness?

1. Understand the fundamentals of how ratings are calculated and slot Soldiers correctly in Electronic Military Personnel Office (eMILPO). Soldiers who are improperly slotted will artificially lower a unit's P-rating and its overall readiness rate. Take care to ensure that your unit is slotting its personnel in a disciplined manner will improve personnel readiness.
2. Use enlisted substitutions within the same grade, one grade lower, or two grades higher when possible to fill shortages in accordance with AR 220-1. Use officer substitutions within the same grade, one grade lower, or one grade higher when possible to fill shortages in accordance with AR 220-1. This methodology is also appropriate to account for Professional Filler System (PROFIS) personnel assigned for Domestic Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Response Force (DCRF), Prepare to Deploy Order (PTDO), or other requirements determined by senior leadership.
3. Count promotable populations as the next higher grade level for all P-level calculations in accordance with AR 220-1.
4. Maximize grade and MOS substitutions to fill critical needs in accordance with DA PAM 611-21.
5. Aggressively grow SGTs and SSGs by holding promotion boards for all qualified and eligible Soldiers in all MOSs. Count promotable SPC as SGT. Count promotable SGTs as SSGs. Factor these Soldiers as part of the unit's available senior grade and assigned MOS skills match. Ensure Soldiers are prepared to attend NCOES courses at the first opportunity under the Select-Train-Educate-Promote (STEP) guidelines.
6. Enforce officer and enlisted Soldier development timelines in accordance with DA PAM 600-3, DA PAM 600-25, and Army Directive 2015-31.
7. Ensure availability coding in authoritative data systems of record (eMILPO and the Medical Protection System (MEDPROS) are accurate reflections of unit readiness, thereby ensuring the weekly Automated Rear Detachment Report (ARDR) generated by HQDA is correct. Check Net USR to ensure all transactions from authoritative data systems are processed correctly.
8. Commanders will make deployability determinations for underlying administrative and legal conditions using eMILPO and medical deployability determinations in MEDPROS.
9. Proactively communicate manning concerns and personnel readiness issues to HRC through S-1 and G-1 channels, USR commander's comments, and the Army Synchronization and Resourcing Process.

My unit is scheduled for a Combat Training Center (CTC) rotation or for a deployment. What stabilization options are available for commanders to preserve readiness leading up to and during the rotation / deployment?

1. Crew Stabilization. IAW MILPER 18-359, crew stabilization is intended to improve unit readiness and crew manning predictability for certain units preparing for a CTC rotation. Crew stabilization applies to select crew members and key leaders seven (7) months prior to the CTC (does not apply to Soldiers on assignment instructions).
2. Stop Move. IAW MILPER 18-359, stabilizes select or all Soldiers six (6) months prior to Latest Arrival Date (LAD) (does not apply to Soldiers on assignment instructions). Can be utilized to supplement crew stabilization.
3. Deletions / Deferments. IAW MILPER 18-359, stabilizes select Soldiers on assignment instructions.

How long should my commander expect personnel to be on station?

1. Expected Tour Lengths. Soldiers in the ranks of private (PVT) through specialist (SPC) will normally remain on station until their Expiration Term of Service (ETS) or 36 months, whichever is longer. Sergeants (SGT) and staff sergeants (SSG) should also expect to remain in a unit for 36 months. Senior NCOs (i.e., sergeant first class (SFC) and above) and officers are assigned to units based on Key Developmental (KD) opportunities, PME requirements, special circumstances, or if the NCO or officer becomes excess. The expected move time for an officer is shown in Army personnel systems as the Year/Month Available to Move (YMAV). Absent an exception, OCONUS tour lengths are in accordance with Appendix Q of the Joint Travel Regulation.
2. Officer Movement. Officer movement throughout the Army is driven by Army requirements, such as PME requirements and KD assignment considerations. Officers are not stabilized like enlisted Soldiers, but their projected departure dates can be determined by reviewing the YMAV of each officer.

Can my commander cross level personnel on separate installations?

1. No. HRC continues to manage units that are not co-located with their corps or division headquarters due to the difficulty of cross-leveling Soldiers in these formations. Unit commanders in these organizations have the same responsibilities for managing non-deployable Soldiers, MOS and senior grade available percentages in accordance with AR 220-1.

Who has the authority to approve Permanent Change of Station (PCS) Moves?

1. The Commander, HRC, retains the authority to approve full and low cost Permanent Change of Station (PCS) moves. Other commanders have the authority to direct "no cost" PCS moves. G1 representatives should route requests for full and low cost PCS moves through a unit's HRC account manager.

How do Medical Readiness Codes (MRC) impact a Soldier's ability to PCS?

1. Medical Readiness of Soldiers. Soldier availability and medical readiness status are increasingly significant in unit manning and personnel assignment decisions.
2. Soldiers with a Medical Readiness Classification (MRC) codes of 1, 2, and 4 are eligible for assignment to units designated for deployment.
3. Soldiers with a MRC 3 cannot be assigned to a unit designated for deployment unless authorized under the rules of their Deployment Limiting (DL) codes as well as their respective physical category codes.
4. Medical Readiness Codes will not restrict HRC from assigning personnel to units not designated for deployment, whether MTOE or TDA.
